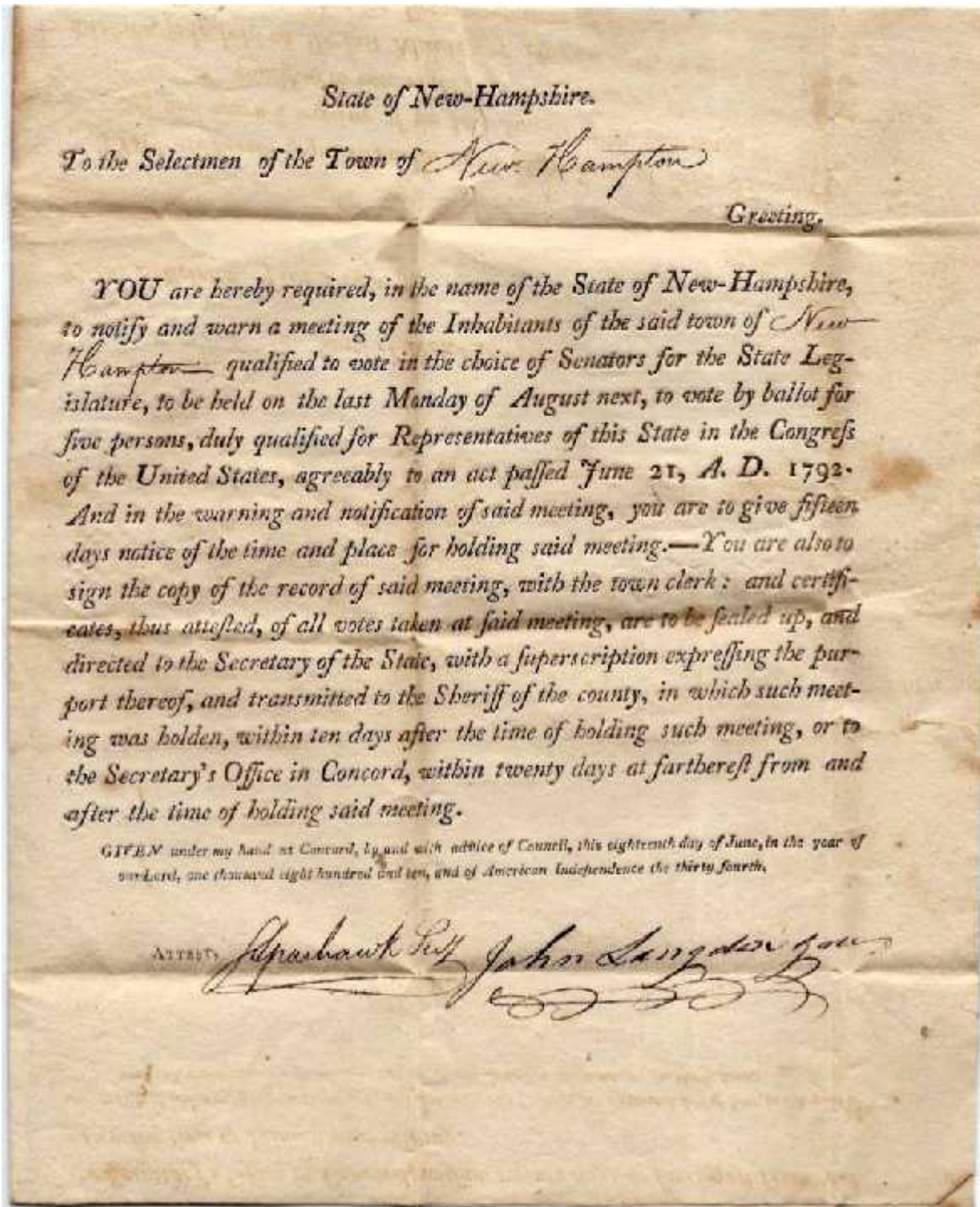


The History Corner
