ORDINANCE

An Ordinance Relative to Drinking in Public is Hereby Enacted

Section I $\underline{\text{Definition}}$ - For the purpose of this ordinance alcoholic beverages and alcoholic liquors are as defined in New Hampshire RSA 175:1 I and II.

Section II Regulation - It shall be unlawful to consume any alcoholic beverage or alcoholic liquor on any public street, public highway, public sidewalk, municipal parking lot, municipal building, municipal beach or any public place or building within the Town of New Hampton. Possession of an open container of any alcoholic beverage or alcoholic liquor shall be considered prima facie eveidence of consumption. Nothing in this ordinance shall preclude the issuance of a permit by the Board of Selectmen, the Chief of Police, or other authorized agent.

Section III <u>Waiver of Liability</u> - All responsibility for the conduct and actions of those attending these permitted functions shall be upon the holder of the function.

Section IV $\underline{\text{Penalty}}$ - Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a violation with a penalty not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100).

Effective immediately.
