REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

The Town of New Hampton is soliciting proposals for the following Paving Projects:

Project #1: Shingle Camp Hill Road: Approximately 3,150 Feet long.

- Shim with 20 tons of asphalt.
- Overlay the entire road with 1.5 Inches of asphalt.
- Raise structures and gate valve boxes to proper elevation as needed.
- Add 190Ft of curbing.
- Mill transition joints at state roads, town roads and driveways. (to be 3.0-Feet wide x width of road x 1.5 inch depth).
- Pave swales.
- In addition provide two(2) 120 ft. x 8ft. swales with 2 inches thick base with a 1 inch top coat.
- Provide sign package and flaggers for duration of the work (road expected to be closed during construction operations and opened up during off hours).

Project #2: Beech Hill Road: Approximately 3,800 feet long.

- Overlay entire road 1.5 inches.
- 400 feet 2-inch base. (End of Beech Hill Road).
- Mill transition joint at Straits Road intersection. (to be 3.0-foot wide x width of road x 1.5-inch depth).

Project #3: Old Bristol Road: Approximately 725 Feet long.

- Overlay 1.5 Inches.
- Raise structures and gate valve boxes to proper elevation as needed.
- Mill transition joint at each end and driveways. (to be 3.0 Feet wide x width of road x 1.5-inch depth).

Project #4 Additional Work: Dana Hill Road:

- Start at intersection of Town House Road and NH Route 104.
- Left over tonnage of pavement to be put down until tonnage runs out.
- To be determined by the Public Works Director, Jim Boucher.
- Mill transition joint at intersection of NH Route 104 (to be 3.0 feet wide x width of road x 1.5-inch depth).

All contractors who plan to submit a proposal in response to this RFP are strongly urged to visit each Project location to take their own measurements. Questions or requests for SITE visits should be directed to Jim Boucher, Public works Director, 603-744-8025 or Cell 603-455-9330.

Proposals shall be a fixed price for each project and any change orders must have preapproval by the Public Works Director, Jim Boucher. Additional work for Dana Hill Road will be at the discretion of the Public Works Director.

Contractors may quote any one or all of Projects 1 thru 4 however added consideration will be given to any bids that include all four Projects. All of the projects must be completed on or before November 3, 2017.

Proposals shall be in a sealed envelope and marked "Town of New Hampton Request for Proposal (RFP) # 2017-50". All Proposals must be received by September 14, 2017 by 4:00 PM, and can be delivered or mailed to:

4. A full and detailed description of the proposed projects.
5. Proposed Completion Date.
6. Certificate of Insurance.
7. Payment Terms.
8. Point of Contact information, including name, phone number(s) and email address;
9. And the following certification:

I, the undersigned, certify that this proposal has been completed in fullest practical detail and that all information herein is accurate and complete, knowing that incomplete or incorrect details may result in rejection of the proposal.


All Paving Projects shall consist of traffic control, site/surface preparation (including FINE GRADING), application, compaction of paving material; finishing and site clean up as appropriate.

All proposals received by the required date shall be opened on September 14, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Office in the Selectmen's Meeting Room, 6 Pinnacle Hill Road, New Hampton, NH.
