

**Town of New Hampton

**Minutes**

November 12, 2012

Commission members present: R. Pollock, R. Kirshner (Chair), P. Schlesinger

The Chair opened the meeting at 7:08 P.M.

I) P. Schlesinger moved and R. Pollock seconded approval of the minutes of the meeting of July 9th, 2012. The motion carried unanimously.

II) DES Communications:

a) The commission reviewed a copy of a wetlands permit application for the New Hampton School, 70 Main St., Tax Map/Lots U3-4 & 12, for road access and culverts impacting 439 sq. ft. of wetland for their new dormitory. R. Pollock moved and P. Schlesinger seconded sending a non-intervention letter to DES. The motion carried unanimously.

b) The commission received a copy of a shoreland permit for Edward Bernstein of Boston for 51 Anchorage Road, Tax Map/Lot U12-11, for a 256 sq. ft. addition.

III) Snake River Conservation Area/Elizabeth Clingan Baird Project:

a) R. Pollock moved and P. Schlesinger seconded a motion to approve the following documents relative to the Elizabeth Clingan Baird Property, subject to legal review:

- 1) Preliminary Stewardship Plan
- 2) Scope of Services agreement with NH DES
- 3) Easement to Meredith

The motion carried unanimously.

b) P. Schlesinger moved and R. Pollock seconded forming a Snake River Conservation Area Advisory Committee (SNARC) with the following members:

- 1) A representative of the Waukegan Shore Owners Association
- 2) A representative of the Waukegan and Winona Watershed Protective Association
- 3) A representative from the public who is not a member of either of the above associations

4) At least two members of the New Hampton and/or Meredith Conservation Commissions

The motion carried unanimously.

c) R. Kirshner reported that the Meredith Rotary Club is considering participating in trail development and construction.

IV) Miscellaneous: Various notices were reviewed.

V) Old Business:

- a) R. Pollock is still trying to get pricing info from Advantage Signs.
- b) R. Kirshner reported that Kirk Titus of Bartlett Tree Service has submitted recommendations about the Main Street tree project.
- c) P. Schlesinger reported on her attendance at Healthy Communities conferences.
