**\*\*WARNING FROM POLICE DEPARTMENT\*\***

A town resident has made the New Hampton Police aware of a phone scam that is occurring in the area. The call is an automated call from Rite Aid and after the computer says your name, you are asked to give them your date of birth. Do not give your date of birth and hang up. The resident called the local Rite Aid and they did confirm that this is a scam. First thing to notice is the caller ID. If the real Rite Aid calls you, they will use their local number which you should recognize (Bristol would start with 744 or Plymouth should start with 536). The scammers are using either an 866 or 800 number. In this case the number called from was 866-219-2430. Secondly, the only time you should give your date of birth is when you call them, never when they call you. If you are unsure if the call is real or fake, simply hang up and call your Rite Aid to inquire.
